EFBs have ARRIVED at ABX AIR

Electronic Flight Bags have been rolled out to all ABX crew members. The EFBs use the Jeppesen FliteDeck Pro software which provides crew members with instant access to all required navigation charts, airport diagrams, and the latest Chart NOTAMs.

In addition, the Comply365 software on the iPad provides access to the Flight Operation Manual (FOM), Flight Crew Letters, Safety Bulletins, and other important information. A protective case is provided with the iPad as well as a mounting system that allows the iPad to be mounted in the flight deck.

The EFBs will eventually replace flight bags which are stored on the aircraft and replaced every two weeks with updated bags. These flight bags contain paper copies of Jeppesen charts and manuals.

On October 15th, the Flight Department embarked on a sixmonth FAA-mandated validation period where the EFB will be used by crew members with the flight bags as backup. During this time, the FAA will be evaluating how our crew members have adapted to the EFBs. Once the FAA is satisfied our crew members are EFB proficient, the FAA will grant final approval to the program and the flight bags will be removed. The EFB system selected for ABX is widely used by several well-known airlines including United, Southwest, FedEx and UPS.



The project to bring EFBs to the ABX flight deck began in February 2018. **Steve Briner**, Manager of Flight Crew Training, has led the project. He noted that a project of this magnitude could not happen without collaboration across the entire Company. Specifically, he wanted to thank the union negotiating committee for their leadership in reaching an agreement between the pilots union and the Company for EFB implementation.

Many thanks to **Joe Freese** and **Rich Kafka** in the Aircraft Maintenance Department for their assistance in the implementation including activating the USB power ports on

the flight deck and the Non-Essential Furnishings guide update. Thanks to **Paul Harding** and his programming team in the I.T. Department for their support and

especially **Kevin Schellinger**,
Tech Analyst, who has been the
EFB "go-to" guy. Finally, thanks to
all of the check airmen who
participated in the trial testing period
including, Captains **Jeff Parrott**, **Matt Kluck**, **Chris Arnold**, **Dan Graves**, and **Dan Valk**.

Steve said the feedback from crew members using the EFB has been very positive, with one crew member writing, "This is awesome.

We need to hurry up and implement this."
